



Food aid for K – 12 students on its way!

Pandemic EBT benefits are being sent on an ongoing basis to eligible K–12 students who have attended school virtually or hybrid due to COVID-19. Students must have been enrolled in free or reduced-price school meals program to be eligible.

Here's what families need to know:

- **No need to apply.** Benefits will be added to your Families First EBT card or a new benefits card will be mailed to eligible families. Hold on to your new card. More benefits may be coming.
- Check with your school district to be sure your child's name and correct address were submitted to the state. **For families to receive this help, school districts must submit information about eligible students.**
- To activate your P-EBT card, check your balance, change your PIN or report a lost, stolen or damaged card, call 1-800-997-3333.
- For questions about your P-EBT benefits and case status, fill out an online inquiry form on the P-EBT page at or contact us at 1-833-581-2214.
- For a replacement card, contact your local County Board of Social Services.
